FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. When do applications open and what is the deadline for applying?
 - For the academic year 2020, admission notice will be released on 21.9.20.
 - The last date for submitting applications is 30th September 2020.
- 2. From where can one download and submit the application for admission?
 - The application form for admission is available at http://ilslaw.edu The form can be downloaded from the website and shall be submitted only via email at ials@ilslaw.in
- 3. Whether course is on line mode or classroom mode?

This year the course is on line mode – due to the COVID19 Pandemic. However, the attendance is compulsory

- 4. What is the duration of the Course and the schedule of the Exams?
 - The duration of the course is approximately 30 units- 3 months- Two hour lectures for four days in a week -.
 - Classes are conducted in the evening
 - Online examination (100 marks) at the end of the course
- 5. What is the Fees structure?
 - Fees for the course Rs.20,000/-+ 18% GST (Fee structure may be change)
- 6. Whether study material will be provided?

Reading material will be provided on line from time to time

7. Where will be the exam pattern?

At the end of the course the final assessment of the student is done which is based on

- Lecture analysis (participants can choose any of the lectures delivered online and review and submit a written report)
- Group discussion (will be organised at the end of he course)
- Attendance for the lectures- 75 % of the total lectures (minimum attendance required for being eligible to get the certificate at the end of the Program)
- final examination.
- 8. Are recent graduates eligible to apply for the course?

Yes, recent graduates are eligible to apply for the course.

9. What documents are to be submitted at the time of Admission?

Candidates selected for admission are required to produce the following documents: scan copies and submit on line

- 1. Passing Certificate of the qualifying Examination
- 2. Or Statement of marks of the qualifying Examination
- 3. One passport size photograph
- 10. What is the cancellation procedure of the course?

Candidate who intends to withdraw their admission must submit an application expressing his inability to continue with the course with valid reasons. The chart for refunding of the fees on withdrawal of admission is as under:

On Cancellation of Admission	Fees to be refunded
1. Within 8 days of admission	80 % of total Fees
2. 9 to 15 days of admission	50 % of total Fees
3. After 15 days of admission	No refund
